



## CREATIVE WRITING WORKSHOP LESSON PLAN

### COURSE DETAILS

Each lesson will take on the following basic structure:

COVERAGE	RATIONALE
<b>PART 1</b>	
A brief theoretical lecture on a literary technique	This allows students to learn about the essential elements which help to contribute to a good story
Excerpts from literary texts which demonstrate the literary technique in question will be given to students and students will proceed to analyse these excerpts	Students will be able to learn first-hand from various literary masters which include Nobel and Booker Prize winning authors
A practice writing session where students will come up with their own original pieces	This ensures that students know how to use and apply the literary techniques that they have just learnt. Furthermore, these original pieces can be used in their examinations.
<b>PART 2</b>	
Challenging and advanced vocabulary will be given to students. These might take on the form of a spelling test or vocabulary multiple-choice questions.	This is done so as to increase the vocabulary of students.
Students will then be given the meanings of the words and be asked to write a short paragraph which incorporates all the new words that they have learnt.	This not only ensures that students know how to use the new vocabulary that they have learnt, but also trains and improves their creativity.
